


Roxio Creator Software: CD Burning

1) Plug in the external CD/DVD drive

- You will need to borrow one of the external CD/DVD drives from the Reference desk.
- Plug the drive into the USB port directly behind the right side of the computer monitor (as shown below).




External CD/DVD Drive



2) Open Roxio Creator NXT 9

- Open the Roxio Creator program on the left of the desktop. 
- Navigate to the "Copy Disc" option on the bottom of the Roxio home page.




3) Copy your original CD


- First, push the button on the front right of the drive to open. Then insert your disc.



- Roxio should detect the source and destination drives (most likely, Drive D). If not, you can choose the drive manually. The **Copy From** and **Copy To** will be the same drive.




- Click the “Copy” button (on the lower right) to create a temporary image of the CD.
- The temporary disc image will begin to save. The screen will appear as shown below.




4) Burn your image to a blank CD

- When finished, Roxio will prompt you to replace the original CD with a blank one. Then click “OK.”




- The message “Your project was completed successfully” will show when your disk is complete and the disc drive will open.




5) Check to make sure the CD works


- After burning, you can verify that the copy is successful by playing it on the computer.
- Reinsert the CD into the disc drive. Click the “Select to choose what happens with audio CDs” popup at the lower right of the desktop.



- Another popup window will appear on the upper right. Choose “Play audio CD.”



- If this doesn't work, open “File Explorer” (the manilla folder on the bottom of the desktop).



- Right click DVD drive. Click “Show more options” at the bottom. Click “Open Auto Play” and then “Play audio CD.”
