
1) Open program and attach the disc drive

- To open Roxio Creator, double click this icon displayed on the left.
- The home page appears as shown below:





• To attach the DVD/CD drive, plug in external disc drive in USB port just behind the monitor as shown below. External disc drives are available at the Reference desk.




2) Select the Create DVD Option


- To begin, click the "Create DVD" option on the home page.
- Select DVD (AVCHD or Blu-ray) from the pop-up menu as shown below:



• You can name your project in the next popup. It will save into the "Documents" folder by default. Use the **Browse** button if you wish to save it elsewhere. Then click **OK**.




The DVD-Video screen will appear as shown. The left panel allows you to select a theme and
access your media. The right panel displays the "Tree Mode" with placeholders to help you
organize and name your videos.

C) Create a DVD with a root menu screen and chapters



• Choose a theme from the first tab on the left (or if you don't want a theme, select the "no menu" option).

1. Apply a theme and upload videos:


 After you choose a theme, click the Apply Theme icon in the lower left corner of the program.




 To access your video(s), click the Media tab to access the "media browser."



 From here, you can navigate to the location of your video(s). Your videos will show at the bottom of the screen.



• From there you can drag your videos into the media placeholders into the **Tree Mode** panel at the right in whichever order you want. The placeholders are on the right of the **Root Menu**. (Note: you also have the option to drag an **Intro** video on the left if you wish).




• You can adjust the size of your placeholder video clips with the scroll bar on the bottom.



2. Organize placeholders in your project:

- In the **Tree Mode** panel, you can choose how to organize your placeholders to accommodate your project.
- The following placeholder options are available to help organize your project:
 - o To rename a menu, click the **Menu** icon in the upper-right corner of a menu thumbnail, click **Rename**, and type a new name.
 - o To add a submenu, click the **Menu** icon in the upper-right corner of a menu thumbnail, click **Add Menu**, and double-click **Sub Menu** to type a new name.
 - To remove a menu, click the **Menu** icon in the upper-right corner of the thumbnail, and click **Remove**.

Your project will look something like this (note name of project and placeholders):



3. Add chapters into a video:

- You can add chapters within a video. In the Tree Mode panel, click the Menu icon upper-right corner of the thumbnail for the video to which you want to add chapters.
- Click **Add Chapters**. The Chapter tab opens in the Media Browser.
- On the Chapter page, you can do one of the following:
 - Below the video preview, drag the scrubber along the time bar or use the playback controls to set the chapter position. Click the Add chapter button.



- Note: The button is unavailable if you have less than 10 seconds between chapter points or between the start and end of the video.
- In the Automatically create chapters area, set time intervals for chapters by entering values for the minutes (Min) and seconds (Sec), and click the Create Chapters button.





• If you want to customize the name for your chapters, in the Tree Mode panel, double-click the chapter name at the top of a chapter thumbnail and type a name.

4. Check disc capacity and preview your project:

You can check your disc capacity on the bar at the lower right of the program:



• To preview your project before burning, click the play button in the upper right corner. Video controls are on the left of the video.



5. Burn your project to a disc:

To burn your project to a disc, click the Burn icon in the upper left.
 (Make sure your disc is inserted into the portable DVD/CD player).



A popup window will appear informing you that the disc has started burning.




• When your disc is complete, you will see the following message:




D) Create a DVD without Root Menu and chapters

You can burn your DVD without using a Title Menu or chapters. Click the Menu icon the Root Menu and then select "Delete Root Menu."



• This will remove the **Root Menu** and the **Intro Video** placeholders. The Screen will appear as shown below:



- Drag your video(s) into the media placeholder that reads "Drag your content here."
- After you drag your video clip, another media place holder will appear.
- If you wish to add another clip, you can drag it into the new placeholder. If not, you are ready to burn your disc.
